## 2021 RENTAL DETAILS

SUMMER HOURS 8AM-8PM

**Pontoon Boats:** eight 24' 2021 Crest 240 with 90hp Honda outboard. 15-person capacity.

- May add Cragun's Driver \$40/hr
- Gas included
- Bimini top over rear seats
- May rent tubes or kids skis, wakeboard, or kneeboard (non-reservable) with pontoons
- All have Radios, with Bluetooth
- Top speed of 18 to 25 mph depending on amount of people on board
- Swim ladder off the stern of the pontoon

**Speedboats:** three 2021 SeaRay SPX 190. 115hp Mercury outboard. 9-person capacity.

- May add Cragun's Driver \$40/hr
- Gas is not included
- May rent tube, skis, kneeboard, or wakeboard with Speedboat
- All have Radios, with Bluetooth
- Top speed of 25 to 35 mph depending on amount of people on board
- Swim ladder off stern of boat

**Fishing Boats:** four 14' aluminum Lund with 15hp Mercury. 4-person capacity

- Gas included
- Marina has bait to purchase, and fishing rods to rent
- Fishing License can be purchased online at MN DNR website

**Wakeboard Boat:** 2017 Axis T23: 13-person capacity. Only can be rented with a Cragun's Driver.

- Ski, kneeboard, wakeboard, wake surf, banana boat or tube, all experience levels are welcome, if you are a total beginner, we will teach you everything you need to know
- We have a "learn to ski boom" for young kids or beginners.
- The boat is equipped with a heater if guest is worried about getting cold
- Different Group/family members can choose different water sports during their outing.
- Banana boat tube can hold 12 passengers.
- If group chooses to Banana boat, that is the only activity they can do during their time slot, if banana boat group is over 12 people, we can switch off passengers on the docks.

**Jet Skis:** four 2021 Yamaha EX Sports. 1000cc engine 2-person capacity or 400 lbs.

- No tow behind watersports on Jet Skis (ropes get sucked up into impeller)
- 21 years old to rent, under 18 years old must have adult on board to drive.
- 14-17 years old Must have someone at least 21 on board.
- Top speed of 40 mph
- Gas is not included
- Can not be rented before 9:30AM
- All Jet skis must be back one hour before legal sunset time

### **Guided Fishing Trip:**

- Multiple fishing guides may be booked at once to accommodate for large groups
- Guides can take up to 3 adults in their boats, 4 if two are young kids
- Larger family fishing trips can be booked with the guides on pontoons
- Guests pay guides directly

**Non-motorized equipment** – Minors may take equipment on their own if it is signed out by parent/guardian. Marina staff will make decision if a day is too windy for non-motorized rentals.

- 7 Canoes accommodate: 21 (people)
- 9 Kayaks accommodate: 10
- 3 Hydro Bikes accommodate: 3
- 4 Paddleboats accommodate: 14
- 10 Paddleboards accommodate: 10
- 6 Adult Bikes accommodate: 6
- 6 Kids Bikes accommodate: 6

### **Electric Bikes:**

- 8 Adult E-Bikes
  - 18 years old to rent, Ages 16 and 17 must be accompanied by adult
  - No one under 16 may ride E-bikes (must have driver's license since it's a motorized vehicle)
  - Credit card only. You may not use cash or room charge to rent E-bikes

### **Cragun's Docks and Boat access:**

- Cragun's has seven different docks along our shoreline for guests to park their boats at during their stay, for free.
- Dock space is non-reservable and is a first come first serve basis
- Cragun's has a boat access at the marina which is free to use for Cragun's guests.
- The marina sells 91-nonoctane gas on the dock to guests and non-guests

### **Life Jacket:**

- Minnesota law requires one U.S. Coast Guard approved, properly sized, and easily accessible life jacket for each person on the boat.
- All children under ten are required to wear an approved life jacket at all times while in a boat.
- Anyone on a jet ski must wear a life jacket at all times
- One throwable is required on all watercrafts over 16 feet long
- A readily available life jacket must be available in canoes, kayaks, paddleboards and paddleboats for all passengers.

### **Gull Lake Information:**

- Cragun's is on Steamboat Bay, on the south end of Gull Lake
- 3 miles to Ernie's
- 9 miles to Zorbaz and Bar Harbor
- 4 miles to Dock 77/Quarterdeck Resort
- 38 miles of shoreline
- 10,000 acres
- Deepest spot 85 feet
- Main fish species: Largemouth Bass, Walleye, Northern Pike, Sunfish, Crappie
